ITALIAN PROGRAM

Prep

The students will focus on introducing themselves in Italian. The teacher will ask the question “What is your name?” and the students will answer in an Italian sentence. They will also practice asking each other what their names are. The students were introduced to the Pappagallo (Parrot) last term with the focus on the Family. This term, the focus is on the Italian colours. They will learn the colour names through games such as Snap, Hangman and Memory game. The students will sing songs related to colours and complete speaking and listening tasks.

Grade 1/ 2

The students will be looking at the vocabulary of the Weather through the Italian version of the fable “The Sun and the Wind”. The students will learn the vocabulary related to the weather and be able to describe the weather with the use of the weather word chart. They will learn the weather song related to the story of the “The Sun and the Wind” and be able to express likes and dislikes for hotter or colder weather in their writing.

Grade 3/ 4

The students will be introduced to the vocabulary of Hobbies through games and written activities. They will be able to construct sentences on activities they would like to do during the week, incorporating the language of the days of the week in Italian. They will express preferences for certain activities in their speaking and listening tasks.

Grade 5/ 6

The students will be receiving a pen pal from year 5/6 students at Mackellar Primary School in Delahey who also learn Italian. The students will use formal and informal greetings to ask about personal preferences and interests such as what subjects one likes, describe physical characteristics such as, eye and hair colour. The focus is on communicating through written Italian.
