Dear parents and carers

Today the Acting Premier announced that the circuit breaker restrictions for Victoria will continue for another 7 days, ending on Thursday 10 June at 11.59 pm.

Following advice from the Victorian Chief Health Officer, all Metropolitan Melbourne primary schools will continue remote and flexible learning. School will resume on Friday June 11, 2021. Some different arrangements are in place for secondary schools.

Our school will provide remote learning programs. Year 1-6 students should continue to log on to Google Classroom each morning. Teachers will be contacting families when students have not logged on.

All teachers will be holding Google Meets with students.

The Prep team will hold some Zoom sessions.

The tutoring program and the LLI programs will continue online, and students have been notified of their session times.

**Prep families** can collect learning packs from the office between 9-11am on Monday.

### **iPad loans**

Manorvale Primary School has an extremely limited number of iPads available for students to borrow during remote and flexible learning. These will be prioritised to year 1-6 students who do not have access to any alternative at home and were not provided with one last year.

### **Hard Copy Packs**

Hard copy packs are also available during remote and flexible learning for any student who is unable to connect online. Hard copy packs will be available for collection from the school office on Monday morning between 9am – 11am.

### **Passwords**

If you need access to any passwords or accounts that you are unable to get from the teacher on google classroom, please call the office on 9741 6300 or come in on Monday 9am – 11am for support

**As with other remote learning periods, our school will provide on-site supervision for students in the following categories:**

- **Children where both parents and/or carers are [authorised workers](#) who cannot work from home, work for an essential provider and where no other supervision arrangements can be made:**
  - Where there are two parents/carers, both must be authorised workers, working outside the home in order for their children to be eligible for on-site provision
  - For single parents/ carers, the authorised worker must be working outside the home in order for their children to be eligible for on-site provision.
- **Children experiencing vulnerability, including:**
  - children in out-of-home care
  - children deemed vulnerable by a government agency, funded family or family violence service, and is assessed as requiring education and care outside the family home
  - children identified by a school or early childhood service as vulnerable, including via referral from a government agency, or funded family or family violence service, homeless or youth justice service or mental health or other health service.

Onsite supervision is available from **9 am to 3.05 pm**.
