Term 3, 2021 LIBRARY & DIGITAL TECHNOLOGIES PROGRAM Mr Giblin

During Term 3, all grades will continue to focus on reading stamina and literature selection in Library. Book Club will run twice during the term.

In Digital Technologies all students will focus on identifying different types of data. They will begin to recognise and explore patterns in data and represent data as text, pictures, symbols and diagrams. They will then explore how the same data can be represented in different ways.

Prep

Focus on shared reading, introducing and reinforcing recognition of book parts: Title, Author, Illustrator and call number.
