**LIBRARY AND DIGITAL TECHNOLOGIES Mr Giblin**

During Term 2, all grades will continue to focus on establishing or reinforcing both Library and Computer Lab's rules and routines.

Each year level will address the following points in their lessons:

## **Prep**

Introduction to the library rules and routines including borrowing.

Focus on shared reading, introducing book parts; Title, Author, Illustrator and call number.

Look for links between real life and text.

Reinforcement of computer lab, rules and routines.

Reinforcement of use of passwords and naming computer parts.

Explore a variety of hardware (computer and iPads) to access software (applications and websites).

## **1/2**

Reading, browsing and borrowing.

Building up to 16 minutes sustained silent reading.

Library shelf organisation and management.

Questioning before, during and after reading a book.

Recognising and exploring digital systems both hardware and software.

Focus on remembering storing passwords and keeping them secure.

Engage and explore types of data and represent data as pictures, symbols and diagrams.

Use applications to respond to and review literature read in library sessions.

## **3/4**

Reading, browsing and borrowing.

Building up to 16 minutes sustained silent reading.

Library shelf organisation and management including Fiction books.

Questioning before, during and after reading a book.

Labelling parts of a computer, recognising inputs and outputs.

Focus on remembering storing passwords and keeping them secure.

Establishing routines and activities in Purple Mash and Google Classroom.

Recognise different types of data and explore how the same data can be represented in different ways, pictures, drawings, charts etc.

## **5/6**

Reading, browsing and borrowing.

Building up to 16 minutes sustained silent reading.

Questioning before, during and after reading a book.

Organise own thinking in the form of visual representations using graphic organisers.

Library shelf organisation and management including Non-Fiction books.

Labelling and describing parts of a computer, recognising inputs and outputs.

Focus on remembering storing passwords and keeping them secure.

Establishing routines and activities in Purple Mash, Google Classroom and Studyladder.
